School Uniform

All pupils should be in winter uniform. Please check the website or Parents' Handbook for details. Please ensure that all items of uniform are named, including your child's PE kit. We have a number of items that go into lost property but are never claimed and cannot be returned as they have not been named. It is also important when children use facilities, such as Tea Time Club, so that we can ensure that children take the correct uniform items!

Years 3-6 Morning Drop Off

Children in Years 3 to 6 are welcomed into the playground before school from 8:20 to 8:30am. This allows parents to use the 'drop and go' lane or to park and walk their child to the playground. There is no need to wait for your child once he or she is in the playground as Mr. Robinson will be there to supervise the children. We respectfully request, that as soon as your child is being supervised, you return to the car park to remove your car. This enables later arrivals to park and keeps the school traffic flowing. We thank you for your co-operation.

May we also respectfully remind parents that they should not enter classrooms unless a member of staff is present.
