I hope that you all had an enjoyable half term; half way through the year already and finally Spring has arrived!

#### 11+ Entrance Examinations

For our Year 6 pupils and parents, January and February have been nerve wracking times. From the last term of Year 5 through the Autumn term of Year 6, the pupils have been hard at work preparing for their entrance examinations to a variety of different senior schools. This year we had thirteen pupils sitting examinations for fourteen different independent schools. They finished covering the curriculum requirements at the end of Year 5 and set off in earnest on the challenging trail of practice papers and mock interviews with Mrs Daines, Year 6 teacher. Each week they have tackled sample questions and past papers in English, Maths and Reasoning as well as revisiting areas where they were not a 100% secure.

The final results for independent senior schools have now been released and we are very pleased with the results. Most pupils are in the enviable position of having some difficult choices to make as they have received several offers, including four academic scholarships, two sports scholarships and an IT scholarship.
