SOME REMINDERS

Car Parks

Please reduce your speed when approaching the school on our driveway and drive carefully in our car parks. We have seen some cars drive far too fast with young children walking nearby. Assume that children and adults will be around you. Our maintenance team helps with parking - please take note of their directions. If you are using the "Drop Off" lane, please do so as swiftly as possible to avoid causing congestion. Never let your children wander around the car parks unsupervised.

School Uniform

Although we have taken a more relaxed approach to school uniform this term due to the various supply issues, I would like to remind families that children should come to school in their full school uniform if they are not having PE or an after school club.

We take great care to maintain high standards of uniform and presentation at school, and as we return to wintery weather I would like to remind you that after half term, all pupils should be wearing the winter uniform. This includes the regulation school coat purchased from the uniform shop; please do not wear alternative coats. In cold weather, the school woollen hat and scarf, which are available from the uniform suppliers, should be worn. No pupils should wear coloured or patterned hats, gloves or scarves.

Boots are not a part of school uniform, including the Early Years classes, so please make sure that pupils have sturdy black school shoes through the winter. When it snows, pupils may wear boots to and from school but will need to wear shoes on site and in the buildings.

We will text you via our 'Groupcall' texting facility and we share highlights on social media several times each week!

Open Morning

We are holding a virtual Open Morning for prospective and current parents on Tuesday 6 October. This is a good opportunity to view the school at work and refresh your memories of areas of the school with which you may be less familiar. Some New Initiatives this Term

EducationCity

All the children from Kindergarten to Year 6 should have brought home login details for a new platform we introduced in school. Some of the homework for all of the children will be set on EducationCity during the week. If you have not yet logged on, please do that as soon as possible.

Seesaw

Another new platform we have introduced to children from Year 1-6 is Seesaw. In the simplest term; Seesaw is like a child friendly Facebook between your child and their teachers. Teachers can set work on Seesaw, children then 'post' their work for the teachers to mark it online. The login details for Seesaw should reach you by the end of this week.

Self-Isolation

As you will know, Year 3 and 4 had to start self-isolation earlier this week. The process of getting all the children home and set up for remote learning went really well. During the first weeks in school, the staff have been working incredibly well on training and getting ready for a possible lockdown. I am very thankful and proud of how well the staff have adjusted to living with the possibility of remote learning. Both EducationCity and Seesaw will be used more during any self-isolation periods.

The same procedures will be followed if we have to isolate another bubble, and we have decided to make some changes to the sizes of the bubbles in school. From Monday, each year group will be in their own bubble. None of the year groups will share time in school with any other year group. In order to facilitate this, Miss Crick had the mammoth task of setting up a new system for break and lunch times that have already started.

May I encourage all of our families to keep following the Government guidelines to keep your family and the school community safe.
