It has been lovely to have all of the children back in school for the first half of the summer term. I have enjoyed walking around and seeing our children excited about their learning and participating enthusiastically.

Following the latest Government update, we are now able to share some dates and events with you.

Class Photos

We were not able to take any class photos at the end of last year. Fortunately, we can now invite our photographers back into school. They are booked to come on Monday 5 July for the class photos. The office will send out another reminder closer to the time. In the meantime, may I remind families to ensure that the children are in their full summer school uniform, including a blazer, on the day.

If your child is in LKG or UKG and does not usually attend school on Mondays, please feel free to bring them to have their photo taken with their class. The teachers will talk to you about the timings nearer the day.

End-of-Year Events

As you can imagine, I am excited to welcome our families back into school at the end of the summer term after a year of virtual interaction, if the Government plans are confirmed on Monday 21 June. I would never have thought that my first year at Coopersale Hall School would involve me meeting parents mostly on Zoom and policing facemasks and social distancing, rather than spending time with parents on site as I had hoped to do.
