# **Leave of Absence Requests**

Please would parents ensure that they do not arrange holidays in school time for pupils from Reception upwards. Our term dates are published well in advance, sent to parents and displayed on the website and App. Taking a week, or even a few days, out of school is disruptive to learning and may affect your child's progress.

#### **Late Arrival**

The morning is an important time of the day so please ensure that you arrive in time for registration. The teachers do a variety of work with the children on arrival including making up work missed through absence, reading, verbal reasoning, maths skills and handwriting practice. Please sign in at the office if you arrive after 8.45am.

Some of our families continue to arrive late most mornings; we will contact those families to set up meetings to see how we can support you in getting your child to school on time. Late arrivals are disruptive to the office staff having to take children to their lessons, it is disruptive to the other children in your child's class and then most of all disruptive to your own child's learning.

If your child's dietary or medical needs change, please inform the office in writing or by email so that the details we hold on our system can be updated.
