Our Year 6 children have been working extremely hard; the majority have sat challenging entrance examinations for various senior independent schools throughout December and January. They have all continued to fulfill their prefect duties every day and acted as role models to the younger children of the school despite the pressure of the examinations. 11+ Entry Exams To Enter Year 7

It has been lovely to meet so many excellent 11+ candidates this year who have applied to join Coopersale Hall's inaugural Year 7 class in September. As well as sitting their exam papers with us, I have met each of them for an interview and had the opportunity to talk to them about our school. Offers will be sent out at the end of this half-term. Some of our internal Year 6 pupils have also applied for scholarships in areas where they are particularly talented and I shall be interviewing these applicants over the next week. Our Year 6 pupils were excellent ambassadors for Coopersale Hall School on the examination day. They welcomed the prospective pupils warmly, as well as approaching the exam papers with maturity, determination and focus. I was very proud of them all.

Children's Mental Health Awareness Week 6 – 12 February 2023

If you are unavoidably delayed bringing your child to school and arrive later than 8.45am, please do not take them to their classroom, but sign in first at the office, from where they will be taken to their class by a member of the office staff.

Flux's Lane

More of our families are walking to school during the drop-off and pick-up times. This is something we want to encourage need our families to be aware that small children often walk in the designated area along the side of our lane. Please be patient with these pedestrians when driving to and from school.

Absence Due To Illness

In the colder months, many of our children are struggling with winter illnesses. May I ask all families not to send their children to school when they are ill. The children struggle to concentrate during lessons and germs spread through the year groups rapidly. We want to make sure that our staff stay well enough to continue to provide a high level of education to the children.
