EXTRA SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES

Specialist Support Teaching is available and can be arranged through the SENDCo team at a termly cost of £175 for thirty minutes per week and £350 for one hour per week.

PAYMENTS

A registration fee of £50 is payable on completion of the School Registration Form. When the offer of a place is accepted, a non-returnable deposit of £500 will be charged. This will be deducted from the first term's fees.

Fee invoices are due to be settled on the first day of each term and please note that interest of 2.5% will be charged on all fees outstanding after this date in accordance with the School's Terms and Conditions.
