## **Snow and Wintry Weather**

Although the weather has been quite warm recently, we are still in winter. Our aim is always to stay open even in snowy weather, unless there is a health and safety concern in doing so. The maintenance team arrive on site early to clear paths and to make the site safe, and an update will be posted on the website by 7.15am so that parents are informed about arrangements for the day.

Please ensure that your children wear the appropriate plain hats, scarves and gloves, according to the uniform list, during wintry weather. If boots are worn to school in snowy weather, shoes should be brought to change into on arrival.

#### **Late Arrival**

If you are unavoidably delayed bringing your child to school and arrive later than 8.40am, please do not take them to their classroom, but sign in first at the office, from where they will be taken to their class by a member of staff.

#### Absence due to Illness

In the colder months, lots of our children are struggling with winter illnesses. Please do not send the children to school when they are not well. The children struggle to concentrate during lessons and germs spread through the year groups rapidly. We want to make sure that our staff stay well enough to continue to provide a high level of education to the other children.
