I hope that you are all enjoying what may be the sunniest spring on record and are looking forward to our half-term break.

Introducing Spelling Shed

I am pleased to inform you that, after the half-term break, we will be introducing *Spelling Shed*—a fun and interactive web-based platform from EdShed designed to support pupils in developing their spelling skills. In this initial *soft launch* phase, pupils will receive their individual login details, and teachers will begin setting some introductory spelling tasks for them to explore at home and in school. The pupils will be given a QR code and I will send home very simple instructions on how to set up your PCs, tablets and mobile devices so that the children can start using Spelling Shed.

This gentle introduction will allow pupils, parents, and staff to become familiar with the platform and its features. Once everyone is confident using Spelling Shed, we plan to implement it more formally as part of our spelling curriculum from the start of the new academic year. We're looking forward to seeing how it supports and motivates our learners.

Relationships and Sex Education (RSE)

Thank you to all those who attended the session on Relationships and Sex Education. Mrs Stanley led a very informative meeting that explored the statutory nature of RSE, the right to withdraw from certain elements of the curriculum, and the ways in which we support children as they grow up and pass through different developmental stages. Please take a moment to speak with your child about the importance of thinking critically, making safe choices, and never feeling pressured to take part in dares - online or otherwise. Together, we can help our pupils stay safe and make responsible decisions both in and out of school.

Moving Up Day

Our annual Moving Up Day will take place on **Thursday 3 July for pupil from Lower Kindergarten to Year 5**. This important transition event gives pupils the opportunity to spend the afternoon with their new class teachers, helping to ease any anxieties and build excitement for the year ahead. It's a chance for children to become familiar with their new learning environments, routines, and expectations in a relaxed and supportive setting.

As part of the day, parents are warmly invited to join us on the terrace, where they will have the opportunity to meet their child's new teacher, ask questions, and begin building those all-important home—school partnerships. We look forward to seeing you there and sharing this exciting milestone in your child's school journey.
